The LERC Journal publishes empirical (both quantitative and qualitative) and theoretical papers on topics related to language education. Submissions are encouraged from full-time and part-time LERC instructors. Benefits to authors include peer review of papers, writing support, and career development. Papers must be written in English or Japanese, with a minimum length of 2,000 words or 4,000 characters (excluding abstract, references, and appendices). Proposals are now being accepted for Volume 19 (published April 2024).

Proposal Submission Guidelines

Proposals must be under 500 words, written in academic English, and include the following:

- **1. Background:** Briefly discuss the essential literature, set your research within the current research, and provide a basis for the rationale of your study
- 2. Aims: General aims, explicit research questions, and hypotheses
- **3. Sampling & Methods**: Research design which includes sample, data collection, and intended manipulations (if experimental)
- 4. Analysis: Detailed explanation of the proposed analytical approach
